

Nursery care. Weeping and gnashing of teeth? There is a "cry room" available outside the worship area. The "Pray Ground," located in the worship space, is for those younger than kindergarten age.

Communion. You are welcome, without exception. If you are hungry and thirsty for unbounded grace, mercy, and forgiveness through Jesus Christ, you are welcome at Christ's table.

Connection Cards. For visitors and regulars to communicate. We won't use your info to bother you. We promise.

Worship Style. We are an intentional intergenerational community. "Sunday School" happens within worship! We sing hymns, we sing songs. We pray ancient words and words that are new to us. We actively practice faith during worship. Sometimes it's beautiful. Sometimes it's awkward. Sometimes it's both. It always "counts" as worship. Then we try it again next week. We are a pro-participation, anti-excellence community.



Dear Hopeful People,

I am always on the look out for God's presence in my life and in the world around me and I've had some clear encounters that have given me life. It's sort of my job as a pastor to have this view of the world, but sometimes I forget. I hope I am always vulnerable enough with you for you to see that I am a human being 100%, just as prone to screwing up as you are, I promise. But I digress...

Jean Gray said to me, "Why don't we pass the bucket at Beer and Hymns for Laundry Love?" Yes! Great idea! That ministry just got \$70 in addition to River of Hope's monthly \$200 contribution to this great ministry. Thanks for showing God to me, Jean.

The Financial Peace University class, initiated and facilitated by Kelly Johnson, is underway. Just a day or two before it started, I reminded folks that River of Hope has scholarships available to help people with the \$100 class fee (for materials). I thought, "Oh, River of Hope will just cover the cost." Suddenly there were 3 more families interested. And then there were 3 families that offered scholarships. Incredible! Just look at that. Thank you, scholarship-givers for your generous hearts. Thank you, Financial Peace University students for being willing to try a new thing. Thank you, Kelly, for sharing your enthusiasm for this program, for sharing your faith in stepping forward to lead. God is at work, folks!

Another opportunity will be arising during Lent to study the Muslim faith with me. I took a very general "World Religions" class in seminary and there are new resources for us to gather around together written by Lutheran theologians in conjunction with Muslim partners. God is at work in this knowing and continuing to love neighbors no matter their religion. It is what our country was founded on. See The Weekly for more information on this class.

I continue to pray for our nation, for President Trump and his administration as well as our local representatives. The executive order banning new refugees and cutting immigration in half has been condemned by our ELCA church body along with hundreds of others. I urge you to reach out to Lutheran Immigration and Refugee Services for information and to help in any way. The story of scripture that is our story begins with God's people (who we come from) wandering in exile. Over and over again, our story and God's story revolves around us trying to separate into groups with God always reaching for us, always breaking down walls, boundaries. God is always trying to close the distance between us and God and us and each other. It's the same thing, really. Thank God that God never gives up on us. Never.




