Welcome. We are so glad you are in worship at River of Hope today.

Come as you are. Well, you're already here. We don't care what clothes you wear or what kind of shape your spiritual life is in. God meets you and loves you where you are.

Where everybody knows your name? We all wear name tags each week - not just the visitors. Even when we think we know everyone at River of Hope, it's simply not true. These name tags are our awkwardly friendly way to help us stick out our hand, say, "hello, you're new to me" and practice being the friendly church everyone swears we are. If we practice this awkward move here, we've got a shot at actually doing it in our everyday lives.

We like kids. No kidding. We think kids are leaders in worship and lives of faith. Just look around you.

Nursery care. Weeping and gnashing of teeth? Nursery care is available just outside the worship area.

Communion. You are welcome, without exception. If you are hungry and thirsty for unbounded grace, mercy, and forgiveness through Jesus Christ, you are welcome at Christ's table.

Connection Cards. For visitors and regulars to communicate. We won't use your info to bother you. We promise.

Worship Style. We are an intentional intergenerational community. We sing hymns, we sing songs. We pray ancient words and words that are new to us. We actively practice faith during worship. Sometimes it's beautiful. Sometimes it's awkward. Sometimes it's both. It always "counts" as worship. Then we try it again next week. We are a pro-participation, anti-excellence community.



Dear Hopeful People,

Can you believe River of Hope will be 5 this summer? July 26 is the date we'll celebrate with worship beginning at the Event Center and ending at the river with communion and a potluck. Bishop Jon Anderson will be with us and will preach that day. 5 people from River of Hope will offer prayers, giving thanks to God for the past 5 years and praying for God's guidance in the years to come.

So I've been contemplating the number 5. What are 5 things you are thankful for that God has done through this community called River of Hope? I want to share the 5 things I give thanks to God for about the life the Holy Spirit has drawn out of this community:

1. Faithful beginners. For all of you who were here when there was painful leave-taking from other beloved church homes to begin this new thing. Without the Holy Spirit working through you, through the Synod Ministers, and through all the other whiley ways the Holy Spirit works.
2. Risk takers. River of Hope isn't a community of passive believers. This start-up needs people who are engaged, have their feet on the ground with their hearts in their mouths. For some, that's been a whole new way of being. I know I've learned a whole lot from watching you move out of your comfort zones to follow Jesus.
3. Visitors, strangers. If we don't interact with new people who come to the Event Center, to Main Street Sports Bar, or to wherever we are handing out root beer floats, well then, how can people know the hope we know through Christ Jesus? And so often, they share hope and faith in ways that would never have crossed my mind. We meet Jesus each and every time we open ourselves up to the possibility of someone unknown to us.
4. Leaders. So many of you over these past 5 years have stepped up and led. You led when you swore you weren't leadership material. You led when you weren't quite sure where you were going. You dared to read scripture and ask questions of it and learn how to pray. You picked things up and let things go. You stepped away from leadership when you were tired. New people have stepped forward. New leaders are always being shaped and growing right in our own midst.
5. 3-in-1. Ok, I know it's not 5. But we confess our faith in God, the Creator; Jesus, the Savior; and the Holy Spirit that calls out new life from within our community. Without this belief, well, we could be any other charitable organization in Hutchinson. But because we confess this belief, we have the best news to share with everyone we meet whether we name it that way specifically or through our actions or through our very lives.


I wonder what the next 5 years will bring? The next 10 or 15? I can hardly wait to see what the Holy Spirit will do with us next.


- Help pre-assemble spoon/straw/napkin & put stickers on cups Sunday, Aug 2 after worship!
