Come as you are. Well, you're already here. We don't care what clothes you wear or what kind of shape your spiritual life is in. God meets you and loves you where you are.

Communion. You are welcome, without exception. If you are hungry and thirsty for unbounded grace, mercy, and forgiveness through Jesus Christ, you are welcome at Christ's table.

Connection Cards. For visitors and regulars to communicate. We won't use your info to bother you. We promise.

Worship Style. We are an intentional intergenerational community. "Sunday School" happens within worship! We sing hymns, we sing songs. We pray ancient words and words that are new to us. We actively practice faith during worship. Sometimes it's beautiful. Sometimes it's awkward. Sometimes it's both. It always "counts" as worship. Then we try it again next week. We are a pro-participation, anti-excellence community.

Dear Hopeful People,

I cling to that phrase, "hopeful people" this morning as I write in the churning wake of the news: peaceful protesters being shot in Minneapolis; a Russian plane shot down over Syrian border; a presidential hopeful running on a platform of fear, wanting to initiate a tracking system for all Muslims. This seems to be the soundtrack, the background noise, and the theme of the day: fear.

But now it's Advent. The church calendar silently moves forward in defiant hope for things to come, the One to come. We do this not with our eyes shut, not with ignorance about today, not keeping our minds so heavenly minded that we're no earthly good.

Advent is a slow reveal of the hope that is present even in the terrible events of global tragedy and our own lives that seem to be falling apart.

Advent points to small bits of light where we think we cannot see. Advent gives us sight in the darkness. Advent tells us to slow down, to wait, to wonder, to keep moving.

Advent points to the coming of Jesus Christ, the one we follow. The one who is with us.

So let's do this together, shall we? We can't do it alone - that's not what being a Christian is about. It's about walking with those around you, reaching out to unlikely and new people, wandering into new places, being open to new things, new people. We follow the star of wonder, the star of might and He takes us to places unknown.

It's scary. It's awesome. Do not be afraid.
