Worship Style. We are an intentional intergenerational community. "Sunday School" happens within worship! We sing hymns, we sing songs. We pray ancient words and words that are new to us. We actively practice faith during worship. Sometimes it's beautiful. Sometimes it's awkward. Sometimes it's both. It always "counts" as worship. Then we try it again next week. We are a pro-participation, anti-excellence community.



Happy Easter Hopeful Ones,

Jim Wallis, the Editor of Sojourner's Magazine has this to say about hope: "Hope unbelieved is always considered nonsense. But hope believed is history in the process of being changed." The Easter story is one of disbelief in the wake of grief. The women head to the tomb and are asked by two men in blazing white, why are you looking for the living among the dead?" When they head back to tell the other disciples, they accuse the women of telling an idle tale. They call BS. And, I guess, who can blame them? After all they've experienced in watching Jesus be killed. After all they've experienced in deserting their friend and teacher. How on earth could what the women have seen been anything but a fairy tale?

This is how the Good News is often received - have you noticed? Like it's too good to be true. Like free root beer floats offered to often incredulous people. Or an open communion table for all those hungry or thirsty for mercy through Jesus. Or help paying for laundry. People just can't believe it. They think maybe we've got a big old string attached.

We cannot be discouraged. The women obviously weren't. And neither were the men, once they went and saw it for themselves. Because we know the reality of this hope in Jesus and we know it does not disappoint. In fact, this hope sets things in motion. Hope is the fuel of change, of transformation. It's what kicks you in the pants to keep you going. It's what comforts you in the dark of night. This is the hope, echoing out of an empty tomb, that nothing will ever be the same again. Love has won.

Happy Easter. Now go and share this love with people in unbelievable ways.


