## Welcome. We are so glad you are in worship at River of Hope today.

Worship Style. We are an intentional intergenerational community. "Sunday School" happens within worship! We sing hymns, we sing songs. We pray ancient words and words that are new to us. We actively practice faith during worship. Sometimes it's beautiful. Sometimes it's awkward. Sometimes it's both. It always "counts" as worship. Then we try it again next week. We are a pro-participation, anti-excellence community.

### River Conditions

Dear Hopeful People,

I will be taking a sabbatical this year and like most things in my life, it's a variation on a theme. Last year, I applied for funds through the Lily Foundation to pay for a 3-month sabbatical. I did not receive that grant and so now have come up with a way to take a breath, to rest, and to return to River of Hope renewed.

Starting in February, I will begin the Shape of Leadership program, hosted by ELCA Pastors affiliated (mostly) with the Southeastern MN Synod. I will meet with a cohort of colleagues once a month on a Thursday and talk about the shape of leadership in the church, particularly my own. Then, beginning in April of this year I will take a "traditional" sabbatical, after the 1st (Easter Sunday — no foolin'). During April, I am going to read and pray and rest. And I am going to scout out congregations that I can learn from that are a day's drive away from Hutchinson. There will be a variety of pastors as well as River of Hope-ers who will lead worship while I am gone.

Then, when I return in May, the rhythm will be for me to have one week a month of sabbatical rest that will most often coincide with the Shape cohort meeting in Minneapolis. The plan will be for me to gone from worship one Sunday and then return the next Sunday to lead worship but not preach. My goal, and the goal for River of Hope, is to have folks share the Good News even while I am in worship so that when this "variation on a sabbatical" ends, we can keep up a rhythm of once-a-month community faith stories. I think it's important that we all have a voice that speaks to the Good News.

I will be reaching out and asking you, River of Hope, to step up and give voice to the hope you have in Jesus in your own life while I am gone. My goal is to spend some good time with you before a Sunday you would do that so you feel supported and prepared and, quite frankly, validated! If I haven't called you and you're interested? Please reach out to me.

I continue to be so grateful for serving River of Hope and helping us to develop together what it means to follow Jesus. I am excited for how God's Holy Spirit will work amongst us this year.
