River Conditions

Dear Hopeful People,

One of my goals during sabbatical has been to deepen my existing practice of reading scripture and praying. Neither of these daily practices are easy and sometimes I miss a day or two and then it feels even harder to begin again. Knowing I am part of a community that depends on reading scripture and praying is a huge accountability piece (and peace) for me.

One of my prayer practices has changed me deeply. I began meditating in January and have found it to be one of the most transformative things I've done. Well, God's done, really. Meditation is praying with your whole body and it ain't easy. Getting my brain to be quiet is sometimes the majority of my prayer experience. However, the longer I practice doing it, the better it gets. So I want to invite you into giving it a go through guided meditation. This might be a gentle way in for you, especially if you've never done it before or think meditation isn't for you.

The meditation is called Loving Kindness. And in it, you practice sending loving kindness to yourself and into the world. The person leading you through the meditation has you say: "May you be well. May you be happy. May you be peaceful. May you be loved." He asks you to first say it to yourself and then to someone you admire or respect, to someone you love, to someone you don't know, to someone with whom you struggle.

What this prayer has the power to do is change what you think about yourself and the world. It's dangerous, but all prayer is dangerous. Because God is actually present with us and in constant communication with us.

Will you join me in this practice? It will change you, one prayer at a time.
