River Conditions

What is next for River of Hope? Who are we and who will we be?

The River Table, your elected leaders, are asking these questions about what is next.

As an 8-year-old congregation, it's an important question, especially as we look around for new leaders, people who want to be plugged in and part of making River of Hope happen. In the life of a young congregation, we are at a typical place of needing to grow, and looking to what is next to help us connect better, to reach out in new ways, to live into our purpose, *We go out to transform lives through Jesus Christ*. The River Table, along with leadership on the other tables of this congregation (Vision, Worship and Music; Parish Personnel; Financial Stewardship) will gather in September at a meeting we're calling The Steady Eddy. Have you ever been given the grace of an eddy in a river? It allows you to stay in one place and gather your party together to make sure you're all still on the same river. Together, the leaders of this congregation will dream and plan how to communicate better, how to reach out to the congregation and into our community. Together, we will come up with a church-wide goal for the 2019 year that each table will faithfully and intentionally work toward. And that, of course, will spill over into River of Hope. You.

How can you be involved?

First, always first, pray and read scripture. Don't let fear of the unknown run away with your love for God and love for people. Prayer will help keep you grounded as we peer into an uncertain future.

Second, ask to be part of a table of leadership. Or attend a meeting of a table to ask questions.

Third, be on the lookout for communication from the tables. We will be asking for your help to take the next steps without knowing if they are the right next steps. The Good News is always that God is faithful and we've got that to share with each other, in our community, and in our world!
