Nan Crary presented the Call Committee report. Four candidates were brought to River of Hope and three were interviewed. The same name came to the top with all eight members of the Call Committee. Background check is done by the Synod. John Paulsen moved that we present the candidate to River of Hope at a special congregational meeting via Zoom on October 4 at 12:30 pm. Portia Brandsoy seconded the motion. The River Table passed the motion. President Scott Gross Sand will give two weeks notice to the members of R of H.

Pastor Janine reported that Confirmation will begin September 23. Students will meet once per month with Pastor Janine, once per month mentor/mentee and once per month "Go Out" with their family.

Sue Benson reported the application for forgiveness of The PPP plan has been completed. August income is about \$16,000 resulting in close to even or a bit positive with expenses. Rent for the Event Center will begin in September so expenses will see an increase.

Pastor Janine will check with Camp Amnicon on the payment made in February for \$1500.

Feedback on worship was given - members were pleased with the organization. Sound is being worked on for online worship.

River Table nominees will be consulted regarding willingness to be on the ballot.

Scott Gross Sands informed us of his plans to relocate to Venice, Florida to be close to family. We are thankful for his service at River of Hope and wish him well on his new adventure.

President Gross Sands thanked the members of our Transition Team, Call Committee and Pastor Janine for all their work and gift of time during the call process.

We closed with the Lord's Prayer and adjourned at 7:45 pm.
