

### THE STORY

Narrator: Our story and God's story continues today, with a reading from Hebrews 2:10-18.

All: Glory to you, O Lord.

Narrator: It was fitting that God, for whom and through whom all things exist, in bringing many children to glory, should make the pioneer of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

All: For the one who sanctifies and those who are sanctified all have one Father.

Narrator: For this reason Jesus is not ashamed to call them brothers and sisters, saying,

All: "I will proclaim your name to my brothers and sisters, in the midst of the congregation I will praise you."

Narrator: And again,

All: "I will put my trust in him."

Narrator: Therefore he had to become like his brothers and sisters in every respect, so that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make a sacrifice of atonement for the sins of the people.

All: Because he himself was tested by what he suffered, he is able to help those who are being tested.

Narrator: Stay tuned for the continuing drama that is our story and God's story.

All: Praise to you O Christ.

All: "Here are my mother and my brothers! For whoever does the will of my Father in heaven is my brother and sister and mother."



The congregation will sing before Milestones – (verse 1 & chorus)






