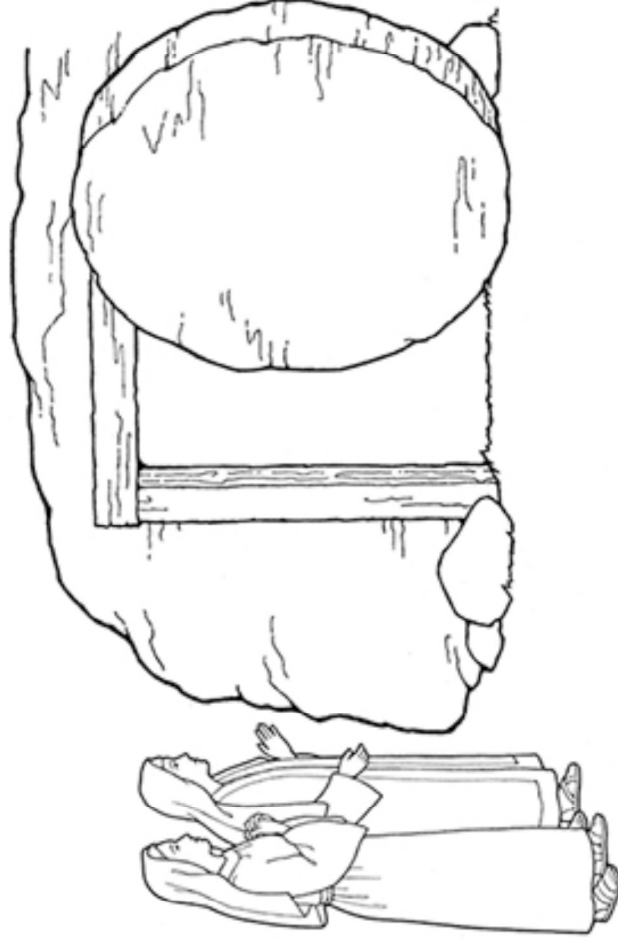


Spices were used, because like the Egyptians, Jews also believed in preserving a body after a person had died.

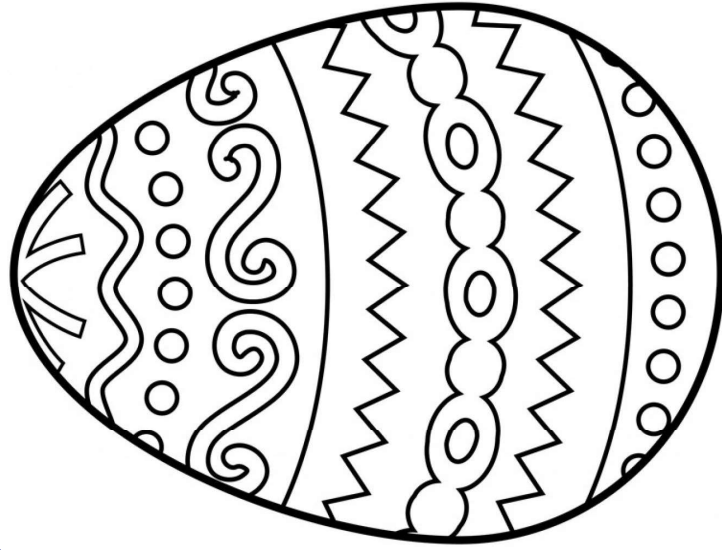

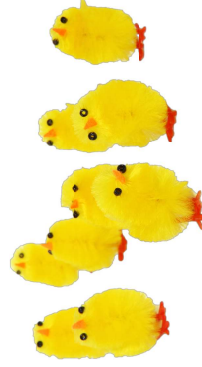

The egg is often used throughout many cultures to symbolize Easter. Color these eggs in beautiful colors. Which is your favorite?

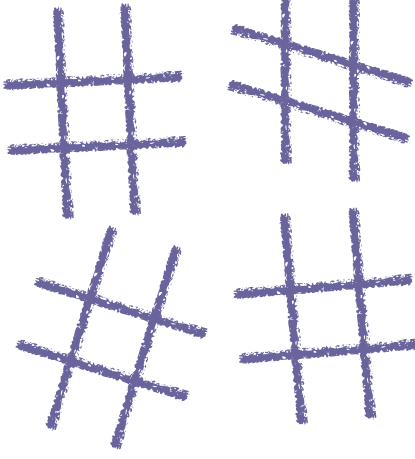


TRY IT AT HOME
