





# THE STORY

(Reader): When they had brought their boats to shore, they left everything and followed him.



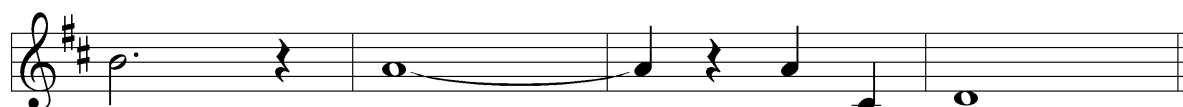
