River Table Meeting Minutes: Tuesday, March 8, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 6:00PM by President Angie.

Pastor Hans opened with a prayer.

In lieu of highs and lows Pastor Hans led a discussion of chapter 3 from the book "Giving to God". Discussed what we treasure and how we spend our money and how it affects our heart. Hans asked us to think about what this means to RoH as we need a 9% increase in giving.

Secretary Minutes:

Everyone acknowledged receiving the minutes by email. Minutes were approved.

Financial Report:

Arlyn was not able to attend. Up to date financial information is included in the weekly online newsletter.

Pastors Report:

Hans will email us a copy of a letter that Brian Tillman has drafted regarding our giving needs. He will also like to see three individuals talk at three services regarding what they take away from the Book "Giving to God". Katie has volunteered to speak on chapter one.

Reports from other Tables:

WAM Table Meeting:

Mask wearing requirements at our worship services were discussed as were returning safely to a more standard communion and the childrens play area.

To mask or not: River of Hope leadership encourages everyone to decide whether to wear a mask at worship per their comfort level according to the new CDC guidelines. We will continue

to monitor CDC statistics weekly for McLeod County and adjust our recommendations accordingly.

Returning to a more traditional communion: It was agreed that we could return to a more traditional bread and wine communication provided we take safety precautions. Discussed pouring wine (juice) into individual containers and handing out bread with either gloves or use of hand sanitizer. Hand sanitizer will be available before and after serving an individual. Those who are not comfortable can continue with the individual communion containers we have been using. Hans will review with others as well.

Hans updated the Table regarding Sunday's service. We continue to not be able to meet at the Event Center. This Sunday we will worship at Art Place in downtown Hutchinson.

We are scheduled to have a slightly shorter service and have a congregational meeting following the service regarding our search for a new worship space. Hans reviewed a "pros and con" PowerPoint presentation he will use. There was discussion regarding asking if anyone has questions or comments. Because some folks are not comfortable speaking up, Katie suggested providing a paper copy of the presentation and encouraging people to write any comments or concerns they may have. We do need to understand the congregation's feelings. At this point we have three possible options. Vineyard, New Journey and 101 Park Place. This Sunday's service at Art Place will also provide a possible option.

Discussion New Business:

It was noted that March 18th is the deadline for letting River Song know if we'll have our Root Beer float tent this year. In the past the proceeds have gone to McLead County Alliance. Could the proceeds go to our youth ministries? The cost in the past has been about \$270 plus a fee for electricity. Ron Johnson has championed this in the past and we will check with him.

Hans reviewed his plans for vacation time. He plans to spend time with family in Spain for two weeks in the summer. He also has a grant to attend a preaching festival in April or May. He will post his vacation plans and dates on the RoH web page.

June 5th we will worship the pentecost along with New Journey at the Good Courage Farm.

The next regular scheduled meeting would be the second Tuesday in April, April 12th.
