



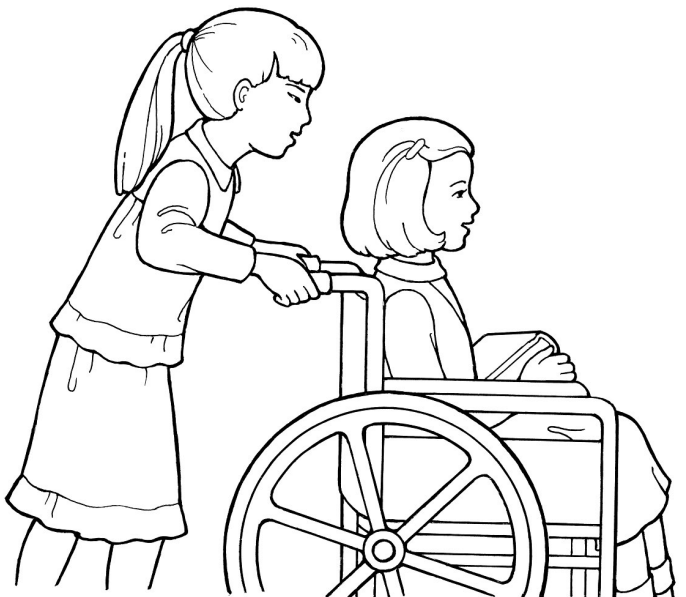
Did'ja Know?

"Got it," his friends said, and off they went.



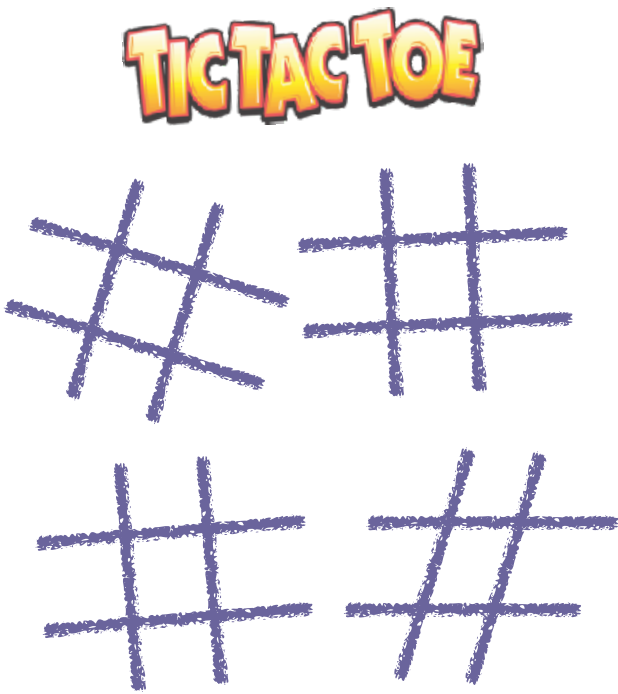
Ministry

A fancy word for doing the work that Jesus taught us.

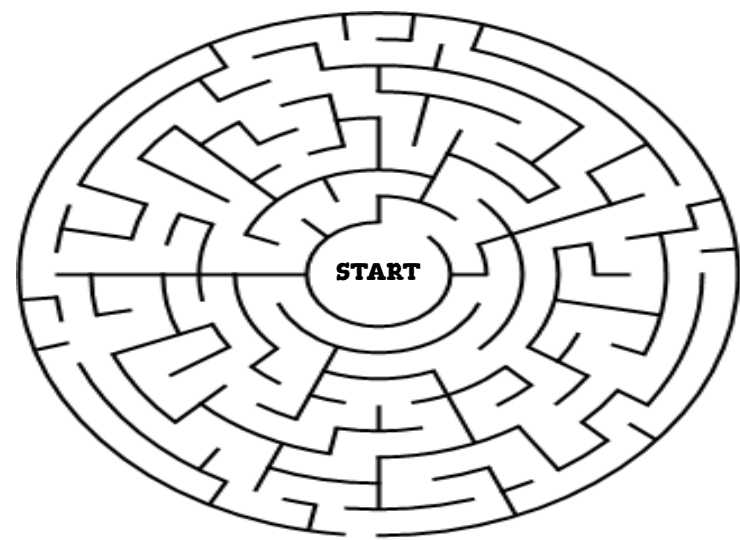
