"Yes," Jesus said. "Life is so much better when we live for God and other people instead of money."



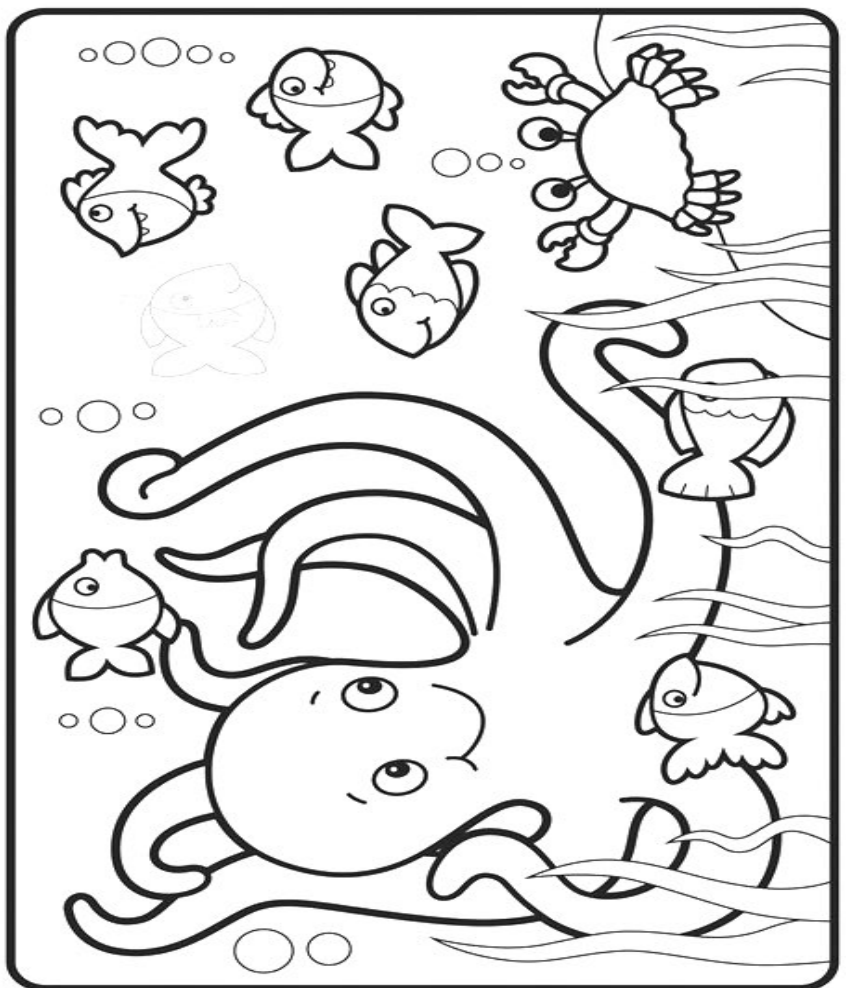
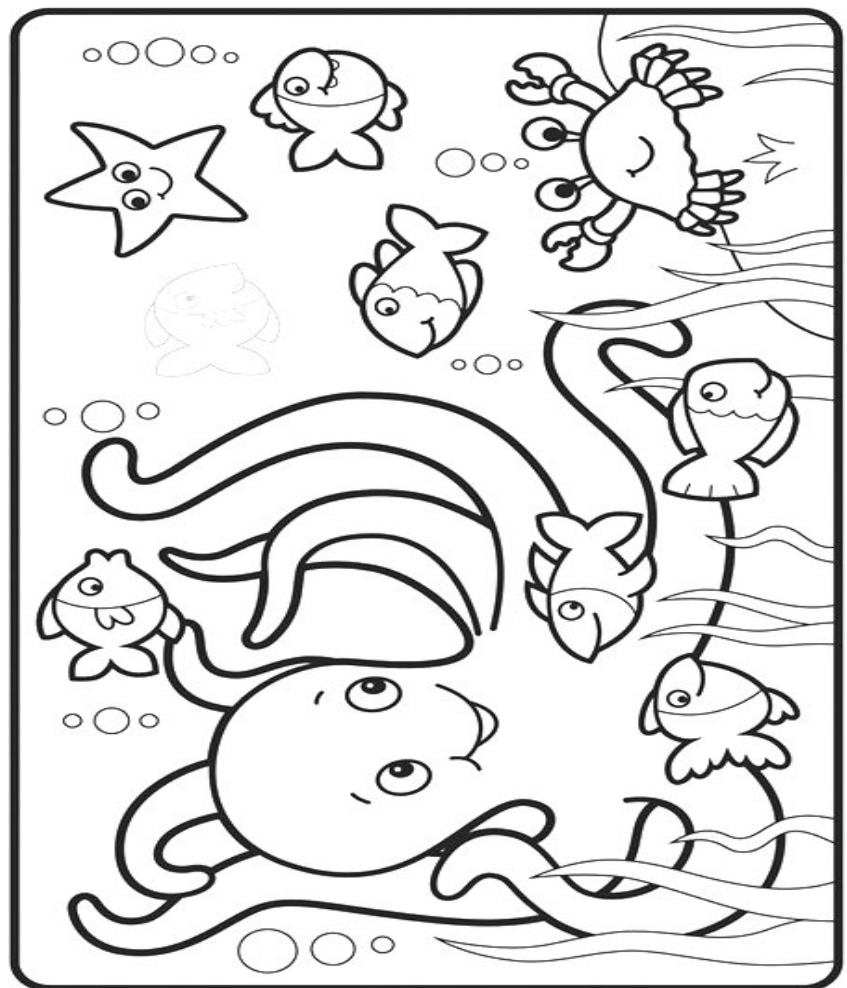
Contentment

Being happy with what you have.

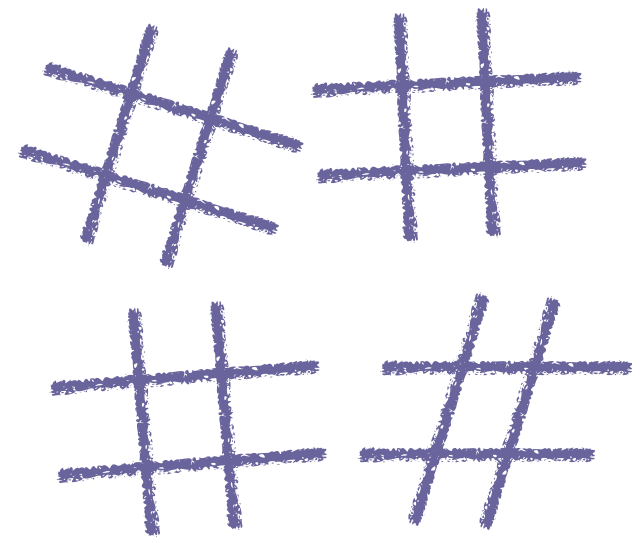


Spot the Differences
