



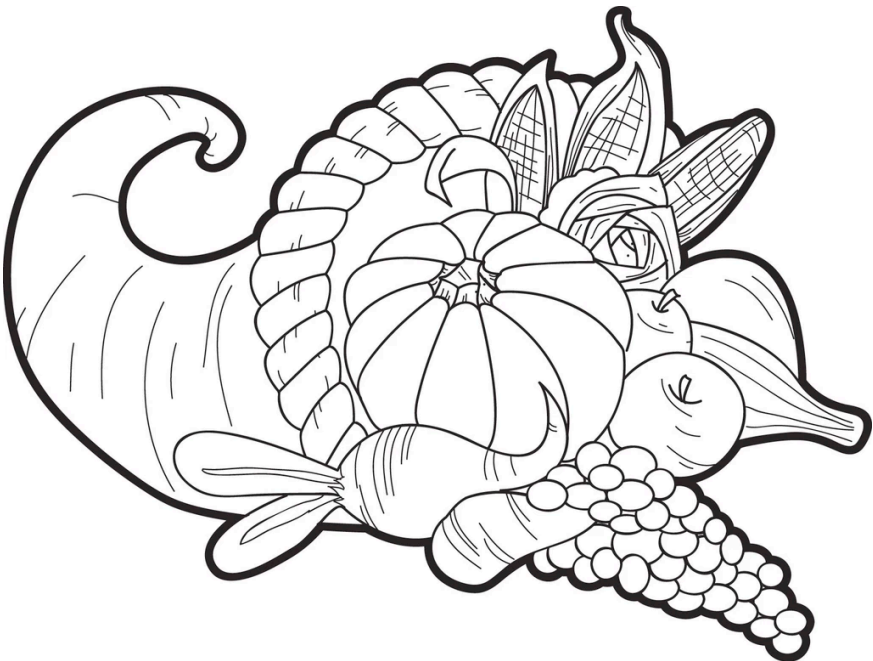
Did'ja Know?

Thinking of others and how they feel before thinking of yourself.

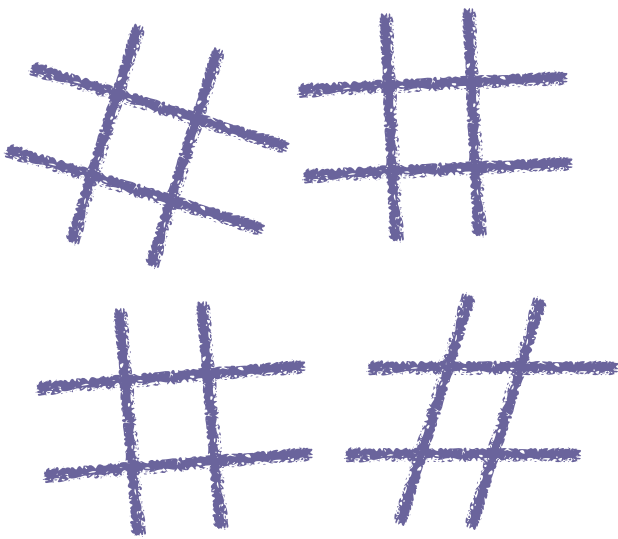
