Greeting


The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the community of the Holy Spirit be with you all. **And also with you.**

The Word

(Reader): Our story and God's story continues today with a reading from the Gospel of Luke 18:9-14.

(Reader): Jesus told this parable to certain people who had convinced themselves that they were righteous and who looked on everyone else with disgust: "Two people went up to the temple to pray. One was a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. The Pharisee stood by himself and prayed:

(Side 1): 'God, I thank you that I'm not like everyone else—crooks, evildoers, adulterers—or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week. I give a tenth of everything I receive.'

(Reader): But the tax collector stood at a distance. He wouldn't even lift his eyes to look toward heaven. Rather, he struck his chest and said,

(Side 2): 'God, show mercy to me, a sinner.'

(Reader): I tell you, this person went down to his home justified rather than the Pharisee. All who lift themselves up will be brought low, and those who make themselves low will be lifted up."

(Reader): Stay tuned for the continuing saga that is our story and God's story

Thanksgiving at the Table






