River of Hope Lutheran Church River Table Minutes August 9, 2022

The meeting was held via ZOOM and called to order by President Angie Pfeiffer-Beddard at 6:00 p.m. Present: Angie Pfeiffer-Beddard, Katie Weisenberger, Arlyn DeBruyckere, Nina Appleby, Jeanette Krommenhoek, Andrew Weisenberger, and Pastor Hans. Not present was Kurt Schultz and Jerry Lindberg.

Jeanette agreed to take meeting notes in Jerry's absence.

A motion and second by Jeanette and Katie approved the minutes of the July 19 River Table/Vision Table minutes and July 21, 2022 River Table minutes as written.

Arlyn presented the budget report for the first seven months of the year. Good news! As of July 31, 2022 RoH income exceeds projections by almost \$36,000. Expenses, however, exceed projections by almost \$20,000. RoH, after first seven months of 2022 shows a positive cash flow of about \$15,000. Congratulations River of Hope! Arlyn also noted that the giving to Laundry Love has exceeded our budgeted monthly contribution. God is good!

A significant challenge was scheduling drivers to transport students one hour each way in the morning and afternoon. Hans also commented how gratifying to see our older students step into roles as "counselors" and "mentors."
