God created all of us with our own gifts. We should share those gifts with each other.

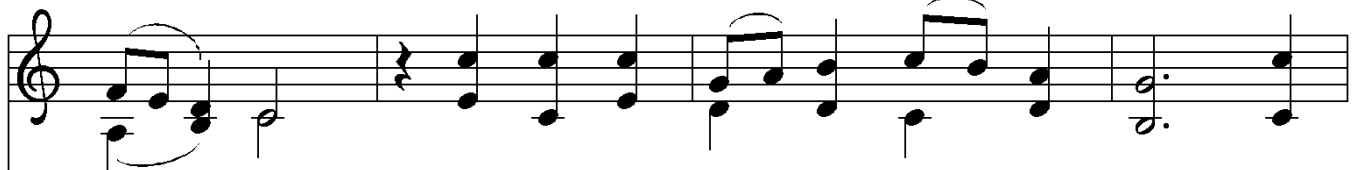
