



THE STORY

(Reader): Our story and God's story continues today with two readings. You are invited to follow along in your Bibles for our first reading from Psalm 37:1-11, 39-40

- ¹Do not be provoked by evildoers; do not be jealous of those who do wrong.
- ² For they shall soon wither like the grass, and like the green grass fade away.
- ³ Put your trust in the Lord and do good;

dwell in the land and find safe pasture.

- ⁴Take delight in the Lord, who shall give you your heart's desire.
- ⁵Commit your way to the Lord; put your trust in the Lord, and see what God will do.
- ⁶The Lord will make your vindication as clear as the light and the justice of your case like the noonday sun.
- ⁷ Be still before the Lord and wait patiently.


Do not be provoked by the one who prospers, the one who succeeds in evil schemes.

- 8 Refrain from anger, leave rage alone; do not be provoked; it leads only to evil.
- ⁹ For evildoers shall be cut off, but those who hope in the Lord shall possess the land.
- ¹⁰ In a little while the wicked shall be no more; even if you search out their place, they will not be there.
- 11 But the lowly shall possess the land; they will delight in abundance of peace.
- ³⁹ But the deliverance of the righteous comes from you, O Lord; you are their stronghold in time of trouble.
- ⁴⁰ You, O Lord, will help them and rescue them; you will rescue them from the wicked and deliver them, because in you they seek refuge.

(Reader): Here ends the first reading. You are invited to stand in body or in spirit as we sing to welcome the Gospel Reading from Luke 6:27-38.

(Reader): Jesus said: "But I say to you that listen, Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who abuse you. If anyone strikes you on the cheek, offer the other also; and from anyone who takes away your coat do not

withhold even your shirt. Give to everyone who begs from you; and if anyone takes away your goods, do not ask for them again.

(ALL): Do to others as you would have them do to you.

(Reader): If you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners love those who love them. If you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners do the same. If you lend to those from whom you hope to receive, what credit is that to you? Even sinners lend to sinners, to receive as much again. But love your enemies, do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return. Your reward will be great, and you will be children of the Most High; for he is kind to the ungrateful and the wicked.

(Side 1): Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful.

(Side 2): Do not judge, and you will not be judged; do not condemn, and you will not be condemned.

(ALL): Forgive, and you will be forgiven; give, and it will be given to you.

(Reader): A good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap; for the measure you give will be the measure you get back." Stay tuned for the continuing saga that is our story and God's story.
