

## We remember the many nameless women in scripture, like the mother of the prodigal son.


God of relationship, we pray for those who are estranged from one another.

Nurturing God, we give thanks for those who enrich our lives by their presence who teach us about your abundant love who encourage us to journey in faith. Amen.


### THE STORY

### Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 23:1–3a, 3b–4, 5, 6 (31)




# (ALL): What my Father has given me is greater than all else, and no one can snatch it out of the Father's hand. The Father and I are one."




