THE STORY

(Reader): Our story and God's story continues today with two readings. First, you are invited to follow along in your Bibles for a reading from the book of Galatians chapter 5 verses 1, and 13-25.


¹ For freedom Christ has set us free. Stand firm, therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.

¹³ For you were called to freedom, brothers and sisters; only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for self-indulgence, but through love become slaves to one another. ¹⁴ For the whole law is summed up in a single commandment, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." ¹⁵ If, however, you bite and devour one another, take care that you are not consumed by one another.

¹⁶ Live by the Spirit, I say, and do not gratify the desires of the flesh. ¹⁷ For what the flesh desires is opposed to the Spirit, and what the Spirit desires is opposed to the flesh; for these are opposed to each other, to prevent you from doing what you want. ¹⁸ But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not subject to the law. ¹⁹ Now the works of the flesh are obvious: fornication, impurity, licentiousness, ²⁰ idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, anger, quarrels, dissensions, factions, ²¹ envy, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these. I am warning you, as I warned you before: those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

²² By contrast, the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against such things. ²⁴ And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵ If we live by the Spirit, let us also be guided by the Spirit.

(Reader): You are invited to stand in body or in spirit as we sing to welcome our Gospel Reading from Luke chapter 9 verses 51-62



(Reader): When the days drew near for [Jesus] to be taken up, he set his face to go to Jerusalem. And he sent messengers ahead of him. On their way they entered a village of the Samaritans to make ready for him; but they did not receive him, because his face was set toward Jerusalem. When his disciples James and John saw it, they said,

(Side 1): "Lord, do you want us to command fire to come down from heaven and consume them?"

(Reader): But he turned and rebuked them. Then they went on to another village. As they were going along the road, someone said to him,

(Side 2): "I will follow you wherever you go."

(Reader): And Jesus said to him,

(Side 1): "Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests; but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay his head."

(Reader): To another he said,

(Side 2): "Follow me."

(Reader): But he said,

(Side 1): "Lord, first let me go and bury my father."

(Reader): But Jesus said to him,

(Side 2): "Let the dead bury their own dead; but as for you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God."

(Reader): Another said,

(Side 1): "I will follow you, Lord; but let me first say farewell to those at my home."

(Reader): Jesus said to him,

(Side 2): "No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for the kingdom of God."

(Reader): Stay tuned for the continuing saga that is our story and God's story.






