

Luke 10:1-11, 16

1 After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them on ahead of him in pairs to every town and place where he himself intended to go. 2 He said to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest. 3 Go on your way; I am sending you out like lambs into the midst of wolves. 4 Carry no purse, no bag, no sandals, and greet no one on the road. 5 Whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house!' 6 And if a person of peace is there, your peace will rest on that person, but if not, it will return to you. 7 Remain in the same house, eating and drinking whatever they provide, for the laborer deserves to be paid. Do not move about from house to house. 8 Whenever you enter a town and its people welcome you, eat what is set before you; 9 cure the sick who are there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.' 10 But whenever you enter a town and they do not welcome you, go out into its streets and say, 11 'Even the dust of your town that clings to our feet, we wipe off in protest against you. Yet know this: the kingdom of God has come near.'

16 "Whoever listens to you listens to me, and whoever rejects you rejects me, and whoever rejects me rejects the one who sent me."

Thanks to Michelle Redding for giving us an update this past Sunday about Habitat for Humanity, our July watering can recipient.

In case you missed it here are some things she related along with additional info:

- Crow River Habitat has the mission of building homes, hope and community for our deserving neighbors throughout McLeod County
- After a detailed application process, those approved becomes known as “Partner Families” because they volunteer as Partners in the development of their future home. On top of maintaining full time jobs, their roles as parents or caregivers, they volunteer 200 hours of labor at the construction site or outreach events for Crow River Habitat.
- In the immediate future, we will be renovating a home that was donated to Crow River Habitat for a deserving family. The project will be a complete gut job, with updates that will make the home more energy efficient, bring it to “like new,” and make it the perfect home for a family who wishes to work and raise their children in this community.
- Not only do we need volunteers of all skill levels, but we need funds to help close what we call the “affordability gap.” There is a gap between today’s constructions costs and what is affordable for our Partner Families. The goal is to close this gap and continue to maintain Crow River Habitat’s ability to serve the community.
