Global Refuge by Zoom with Chairperson Heidi Morlock We intend to honor a 12 month commitment, then taper services in March, 2026. The designated funds cover monthly rent, internet, and some laundry expenses. The Circle of Welcome team at Calvary in Willmar is providing much of the day-to-day support, and is at times overwhelmed. There will be a team picnic Saturday, August 23.
