Greetings River of Hopeful people!

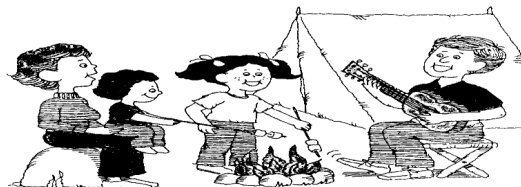
